

Information on data collection pursuant to Article 13 DSGVO

The Company Lehnerts & Müller GmbH, Rudolf-Diesel-Str. 19, 54516 Wittlich, Germany, Managing Director Mr. Udo Lehnerts & Edgar Müller, collects your personal data for the purpose of the execution of the contract, for the fulfilment of their contractual and pre-contractual obligations.

Relevant personal data are the personal data (name, address and contact coordinates including telephone & fax number, email address). In addition, this may also include contract data and support information (including customer development, product & contract interest, statistical data, billing & performance data, VAT-ID) as well as other data comparable with the above categories.

The data collection and data processing is necessary for the execution of the contract and is based on Article 6 para. 1 b) GDPR.

Your personal information will only be used within the organization of Lehnerts & Müller GmbH. Should data be passed on to service providers within the scope of order processing, these are bound to the Bundesdatenschutzgesetz (BDSG), other legal regulations and contractually to Lehnerts & Müller GmbH. As far as we are obliged by law or court order to do so, we will forward your data to the authorities entitled to receive such information.

Within the scope of order processing, remote maintenance is carried out, in some cases factory customer service and/or subcontractors are commissioned (= use of order processors). Customer and system data are additionally stored in an intranet-software (LEC-VDKF). This serves as an electronic logbook and for monitoring the handling of refrigerants. The software is password protected.

The data is deleted as soon as they are no longer required for processing them. This occurs at the latest when the contractual relationship is terminated, all mutual claims have been met and no other legal storage obligations or legal justifications for storage have been established.

You have the right to request information about the data we have stored about you and to demand correction if the data is incorrect, or deletion if the data has been stored inadmissibly. Please send your request by email to datenschutz@lehnerts-mueller.de.
